

## **PERMIT REQUIRED FOR:**



Structures greater than 181 SF



- Decks greater than 181 SF or taller than 30 inches



- Fences




- Room additions, changes to roof area, or patio enclosures




- Pool or Spa (with electric)



- Roof / shingle replacement (full)



Does the work require any mechanical, electrical, plumbing, HVAC, or structural alterations (SAs)?



## **PERMIT REQUIRED FOR:**



- Electrical



- Plumbing



Mechanical, HVAC, or SAs

## A permit is most-likely NOT required.

Work on flooring, painting, replacing damaged or missing shingles, or replacing damaged siding does not typically require a permit.

1. Submit the corresponding permit.

2. The approved permit provides information on the necessary inspections and how to schedule them.
